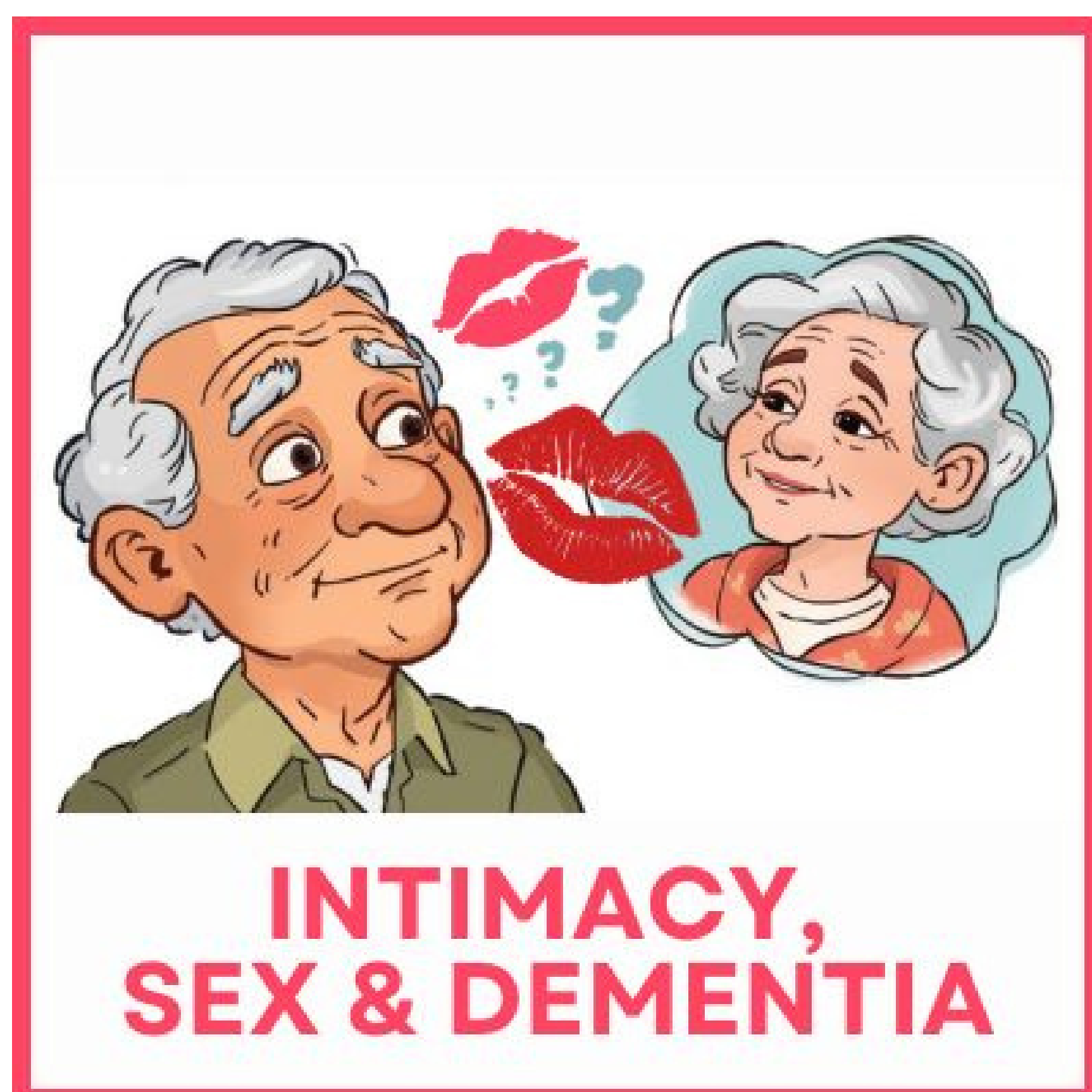
Intimate & Sexual Needs of People Living with Dementia
